1. Scheduled activities, expected results and Milestones

During the third year of the Project, WP2.2 activities focused on the completion of the NextData-INGV Geoportal that allows to inspect and display the Reconstruction-Reanalyses (hereafter RR) data for the Mediterranean Sea covering the period between 1955 and 2012. The WebPortal was implemented and tested in each of its three components (see D2.2.4).

2. Deliverables expected for the reference period

D2.2.4: Design and implementation of the alpha and beta versions of the reanalysis archive with comprehensive viewing and cataloguing services.

3. Activities which have been actually conducted during the reference period

3.1 Research activities

Following the user requirements, the INGV-NextData Geoportal was implemented and fully tested in each of its three components. The web application is reachable at the following link http://medsearr.bo.ingv.it/ and it allows to discover, visualize and download the reanalysis products of the Mediterranean Sea, open and free of charge.

3.2 Applications; technological and computational aspects

The specific activities developed during the third year of the Project were:

- implementation of alpha version Data Layer;
- -implementation of alpha version Presentation Layer;
- -implementation of alpha version Application Layer;
- test of the three components (beta version);
- Final release of the Web Portal.

3.3 Formation

A dedicated side event on "The Mediterranean Sea Reanalysis" was organized in Lisbon during the 7th EuroGOOS Conference. The side event provided a valuable opportunity to train on the methodology to generate a reanalysis and illustrate different applications stemming out of the reanalysis products. The event is also described in details in the WP1.3 activity report.
